Cantigny Park is pleased to announce Art in Bloom, an outdoor arts festival on June 16 and 17. More than 80 juried artists will showcase their work amidst Cantigny's beautiful gardens, grounds and museums.

Art in Bloom 2012 promises even more excitement than our past art festivals, which are always among the park's most popular events. Two-day attendance should be about 10,000 if the weather is favorable. Friday night set-up is available as well as an air conditioned artist break room, snacks, and volunteers galore. This event is located on grass under large trees. Ample parking is another valuable asset!

Our publicity campaign will include, but is not limited to, radio, newspaper, eblast, twitter, facebook, postcards, web, Cantigny Visitors Guide as well as our Spring and Summer Events Guide, posters and banners. In addition we plan on working with many of Cantigny's partners, affiliates and sponsors to help make this art fair the best that it can be.

Cantigny is a 500-acre park and part of the Chicago-based McCormick Foundation. It is home to two museums, formal gardens, picnic grounds, restaurants and 27 holes of championship golf.

Quality of artwork will take precedence over quantity of artists so the show may vary in size somewhat. Art in Bloom 2012 promises to be Cantigny's best arts fest ever! For more about Cantigny, visit www.Cantigny.org.

1. I verify that I created and have the right to display all of the work I have applied to exhibit during the 2012 show(s) I have applied to.

2. I have read and agree to comply with all of the attached rules and regulations regarding participation in the 2012 show(s) if I am chosen to participate.

3. Applicant's release, assumption of risk, and agreement to indemnify. If I am chosen to participate in the 2012 show(s): (a) I, for myself and my personal representatives, executors, administrators, heirs, successors, and assigns, release and discharge EM Events LLC, Cantigny, and each of their parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, directors, officers, trustees, officials, members, employees, volunteers, agents, attorneys, successors, and assigns, all referred to as "releases," from all liability for any injury, damages, death, property damage, or other loss based upon, arising out of, or in any way connected with my participation in the 2012 show(s), whether caused by any of the releases' negligence or any other acts or omissions; (b) I agree to indemnify each of the releases from any loss, liability, or damages which any of them may incur based upon, arising out of, or in any way connected with any of my acts or omissions that relate in any way connected with any of my acts or omissions that relate in any way to the 2012 show(s); (c) I assume full responsibility for the risk of any injury, damage, death, property damage, or other loss based upon, arising out of, or in any way connected with my participation in the 2012 show(s), whether caused by any of the releases negligence or any other acts or omissions; and (d) I agree that the preceding paragraphs 3 (a) through (c) are intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted under Illinois law and that if any portion of any or all of those paragraphs is held invalid, the balance of them and this agreement will continue in full force and effect. I agree to assume the risk if the event is canceled for reasons such as weather, terrorism or other Acts of God beyond the control of EM Events LLC and their clients and if canceled the fee will not be refunded.

show rules & information

ELIGIBILITY & ACCEPTED MEDIUMS

Participation is open to all fine art and fine craft. All work represented must be of an original concept executed and designed by the artist in attendance. Each art fair reserves the right to remove any and all works deemed not suitable at the time of the festival. It also reserves the right to select or invite other applicants in order to ensure balance of medium. In addition, each show, reserves the right to not accept an artist for jury. In the event of this happening, your jury fee shall be returned. Submitting this application implies on your part commitment to show rules.

The following mediums are to be included in each show: ceramics, drawing, fiber non-functional, fiber wearable, paper non-functional, furniture, glass, jewelry, acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, sculpture, wood, mixed media, collage, photography, and printmaking. Individual consideration of any media not listed will be given upon request. Please note if a show is considered a fine craft event, then minimal two dimensional work will be accepted.

No work which has been made with commercial kits, molds, patterns, plans or prefabricated pieces is allowed. Exhibitors may not sell promotional items such as t-shirts, postcards, or notecards. Reproductions are allowed in (1) one flip bin only and must be clearly labeled, "Reproduction." Reproductions are allowed in the following shows: Riverside, Art in Your Eye, Oswego, Northbrook, Cantigny, Lakeview East and West End. If hanging, reproductions must be framed and take up no more than 10% of booth. No card carousels are allowed, even for photography. Minimal, smaller note card items may be displayed on a table for shows that allow prints.

ONLY THOSE ARTISTS WHO HAVE BEEN JURIED IN JEWELRY MAY HAVE JEWELRY IN THEIR BOOTHS.

REPRODUCTIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN Geneva. If reproductions are found in your booth at the Geneva Fine Arts Fair, they will be confiscated. Please refer to each show's page for additional information on their print policy.

E - JURY (THIS IS THE ONLY ACCEPTED METHOD)

- Send four (4) images of work and one (1) image of booth display.
- All images should be in JPG format of approximately 1MB in size and no larger than 2MB each.
- Images less than 200k do not provide enough resolution to be juried effectively.

- Images submitted will receive e-mail reply notification of receipt.

It is the artist's responsibility to make sure EM Events receives images on time. EM Events **will not** follow up with a request for images if they have received your application but no images have been sent. If we receive your images but no application, you will not be juried. If you have not received notification that we received your images then it is your responsibility to follow up and make sure your application is complete.

It is helpful for us if your booth image is from an actual show. Fabricated booth images are strongly discouraged. If we feel that your booth image is not a true representation of your display you will not be juried.

Only one set of images is necessary to apply to multiple shows. Artists are strongly advised to send images of professional quality. Upon acceptance, any image submitted may be used by EM Events LLC for day of show jury purposes and possible publicity opportunity. Once an event has been juried, even if it is cancelled no jury fees will be refunded.

DISPLAY SPACE

The foot print of each display space is 10' x 10'. Each show will attempt to honor specific space requests; however, final booth location will be determined by the needs of each show. Booth location and number are subject to change and will be available one week before each event. Only one exhibitor per booth (except for galleries and Oswego Collaborative show) allowed unless work is collaborative. All areas will be patrolled both Friday and Saturday nights. **Most display spaces are free from obstruction. All spaces are easily accessible to patrons' traffic flow.** Larger display spaces are available for an additional fee.

TENTS AND WEIGHTS

All tents must be white and must be weighted properly. Please check with your tent manufacturer on proper weighting of your tent. If it is deemed by the committee that either your tent or weights are not suitable you will be first asked to correct the situation. If that is not possible then you will be asked to leave the show with no refund available. Milk jugs with sand or water, small bricks or other such items are not considered acceptable weights. We ask that you put as much thought and consideration into how your weights look and function with regards to your booth as you do with your artwork. If you have questions regarding your tent or weights please call or e-mail prior to each show.

ACCEPTANCE/NON-ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION

Acceptance or non-acceptance notification letters will be sent via e-mail one month after application deadline.

SLIDES/DISKS

We are no longer accepting slides or disks for jury purposes. There are many reputable commercial sites available for the processing of slides to digital images.

TAX ID/SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

It is **mandatory** on your application to either list an Illinois Tax ID number or social security number as most shows are required to submit this information before receiving permits for their events.

MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ARTISTS

Maximum number of artists – each show will list a maximum number of artists allowed in attendance at its events.

Minimum number of artists – each show has a minimum number or artists needed in order to proceed with each event. If it is deemed the minimum number or artists has not been reached two months out from the start date of each event then the event will be cancelled and a full refund of booth fees paid to date will be issued. Start date is considered the Friday night before the weekend of each event.

PUBLICITY

Each event is promoted through featured newspaper articles, banners, print advertising, e-blast and whenever possible radio and magazine promotion. Free postcards will also be made available for your mailing list. Most shows also send an e-blast. All events have a strong marketing and media campaign.

AWARDS

Awards are offered at several but not all events. Ribbons awarded where excellence is determined regardless of media. Ribbon award winners selected by professional judge(s). Judges change each year. Award money for each show varies. Call for additional details.

Cancellation and Refunds

The following cancellation and refund policies are in place for each show:

- \$75.00 cancellation fee in effect immediately upon receipt of booth fee check.
- No refunds available 60 days prior to the start date of each event. Start date is considered the Friday night before the weekend of each event.
