## Cantigny Toy Soldier Show on November 7

**WHEATON, IL, October 19, 2010** — Cantigny Park's annual Toy Soldier Show will take place Sunday, November 7, from 9 am to 4 pm. Dealers representing all facets of the hobby will display their products in the Cantigny Visitors Center.

"This is an ideal show for people who are curious about toy soldiers and those just getting started," said Nick Albanese, the show's organizer and one of 19 dealers who will be at Cantigny. "Visitors will see a good cross-section of the hobby, including dealers who make and paint toy soldiers and those who collect them. The variety and scope of the Cantigny show is always very good."

This will be Cantigny's 11<sup>th</sup> Toy Soldier Show. More than 2,000 attended the 2009 event.

Show admission is free; parking is \$5 per vehicle, or just \$2 before 10 am. Toy soldier enthusiasts may also want to visit the First Division Museum at Cantigny, open from 10 am to 4 pm (free admission).
