



## Joel Frankel to Perform at McCormick Museum on April 18

**WHEATON, IL, March 17, 2010** — Cantigny's Robert R. McCormick Museum will host a free children's concert by musician Joel Frankel on Sunday, April 18, at 3 pm.

Frankel captivates listeners with his engaging original songs. Combining his musical talents with a background in education, he presents an energized, creative performance that is stimulating for kids and appreciated by adults.

Frankel's music is heard on FM, AM and satellite radio stations around the world and has been featured on The Learning Channel, MTV and NBC. "We Go Together," one of his most beloved songs, was featured in *Big*, the classic motion picture starring Tom Hanks. Frankel is a faculty member at the Old Town School of Folk Music and performs regularly in Chicago and across the country.
