



## **Starry Nights: Cantigny Announces Summer “Movie in the Park” Schedule**

**WHEATON, IL, June 15, 2010** – Cantigny Park, part of the McCormick Foundation, will offer four family-friendly (PG) movies this summer on a big outdoor screen. The events are free to the public with paid parking of just \$2 per vehicle after 5 pm.

“Movie in the Park” debuted at Cantigny in 2009 with three films. The 2010 series is as follows:

- ***A League of Their Own***  
**Thursday, June 24, 8:30 pm**  
Parts of this 1992 film were shot at Cantigny! It stars Tom Hanks, Geena Davis and Madonna in the story of the first all-women’s professional baseball league, formed during World War II. NOTE: Prior to the movie, park visitors can meet and mingle with reenactors from the Rockford Peaches!
- ***Cloudy With a Chance of Meatballs***  
**Thursday, July 8, 8:30 pm**  
Based on the children’s book, this 2009 animated adventure follows a scientist who tries to solve world hunger only to see things go awry as food falls from the sky in abundance.
- ***The Goonies***  
**Thursday, July 22, 8:30 pm**  
Seven young friends from a small Northwest town go on a thrilling underground adventure in this 1985 film combining humor and heart-pounding peril!
- ***Up***  
**Thursday, August 19, 8:30 pm**  
An old man who dreams of exploring the globe launches his house into the sky using thousands of balloons and then discovers a young stowaway. This hilarious animated feature from 2009 is popular with all ages.

Movie seating is on the lawn, so guests are encouraged to bring blankets or chairs. Picnic baskets are welcome, but alcoholic beverages are prohibited. In case of rain, movies are shown in the Cantigny Visitors Center Theater.
