



Cantigny's Twilight Garden Tour and Wine Tasting Set for June 24

WHEATON, IL, June 8, 2010 – Glasses will definitely be half-full on Thursday, June 24, when Cantigny Park hosts the Midsummer's Eve Twilight Tour and Wine Tasting with [Tasting deVine](#). The event for garden and wine enthusiasts will take place on one of the longest days of the year, leaving more time to drink in the beauty of Cantigny.

"The gardens have a special feel and fragrance on warm summer evenings," said Liz Omura, Cantigny's Idea Garden curator/horticulture education and volunteer coordinator. "And in terms of color, late June is ideal. The Rose Garden, in particular, will be at its peak."

Activities begin at 6:30 pm with a one-hour garden tour, departing from the Visitors Center and guided by members of the Cantigny Horticulture department. After the walk, Tasting deVine will pour samples from Roselle's [Lynfred Winery](#) at the Rose Garden. The tasting session will feature two red wines, two whites and a fruit wine.
