The 300-acre Cantigny Golf complex includes 27 scenic holes, the year-round Cantigny Golf Academy, the 9-hole Cantigny Youth Links and a full-service clubhouse with dining and banquet facilities. In addition, Cantigny Golf is a Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary.
