Art activities for kids, too! Hours are 10 am to 4 pm each day. Admission is free with parking (\$10).
- **Sunday, June 18**

Parking: *Cantigny is pleased to offer free parking on the first Wednesday of every month. The park's regular daily parking rate is \$5 per car. On Saturdays and Sundays, May through September, parking is \$10 per car. The \$10 rate also applies on Memorial Day, July 4th and Labor Day. Parking is free for Cantigny Park members and Honor Club members. Parking also is free for those attending ticketed events or other fee-based programs.*
